Here at u&i care we offer our service user an opportunity to access a bespoke education program provided by us on site for learners with moderate, severe, complex and profound or multiple learning difficulties. These programmes will provide a real life context to promote the development of personal, social, independent work related skills using a person centred programme for each service user.



Who is it for?

Our programme is intended for adults or those approaching adulthood age 16+ with severe or complex learning difficulties working toward independence and life skills. It is recognised that candidates may have difficulty accessing written language therefore our programme will be tailor made to suit the needs of each service user.

Delivery

Our education programmes will be delivered on site at u&i care and within the community depending on each service users needs. Appropriate themed modules will be selected from the ASDAN programmes that are suitable for the development needs of each learner.

Our Aims

To present a framework of activities through personal, social and work related skills, offer a flexible programme to meet the needs and abilities of each service user. To recognise small steps of achievements backed up by a portfolio of evidence and working towards larger goals.

Day services

u&i care understand that leaving a full time placement like leaving school or college can be a difficult time of transition for most people. Sometimes it is equally stressful and frustrating for the full-time carer.

Coming to u&i care service on a day placement can be a positive experience for the individuals in promoting independence and improving abilities. Our service users also benefit from continuous support and have a sense of belonging.
